Video/Audio Bus Monitoring

The Board, as part of the district's ongoing program to improve student behavior and ensure the health, welfare and safety of all those riding school transportation vehicles, shall utilize video cameras on various school vehicles transporting students to and from curricular and extracurricular activities.

The superintendent or designee is directed to develop rules and regulations governing the use of video cameras in accordance with the provisions of law and established Board policies and procedures.
