### Controversial Issues

The Board supports that degree of academic freedom which ensures the rights guaranteed under the First Amendment.

It is the intent of the Board that potentially controversial issues receive presentation appropriate to such issues. Teachers are expected to present as many viewpoints as possible of issues and should clearly distinguish between objective data and personal opinion.

When a potentially controversial issue is to be presented or has occurred spontaneously, the principal will be so informed as soon as possible by the classroom teacher.

The superintendent shall develop administrative regulations to carry out the intent of this policy and develop a process whereby citizens may register concerns or lack of understanding about instructional materials used in schools.
