Promotion of Community Service Activities

The Board will be supportive of community projects and recognized state and national service projects. Within the context of this policy, the district will allow the posting of fund-raising activities and registration materials in district facilities.

Requests for student participation and posting of materials must be approved by the superintendent or designee five days prior to distribution of the materials to the site. The agency involved will provide the necessary materials and copies. The materials will be made available for students, but will not be distributed to individual students.

Posting of project-related materials does not require, nor does it infer, that staff time will be expended in support of the fund-raising activity. District employees shall not be required to collect and/or record funds, disperse awards or participate in the related activities.

The solicitation and sale of travel services to students may be permitted with approval of the superintendent or designee on school property, at activities under the jurisdiction of the district and at interscholastic activities administered by a voluntary organization approved by the State Board of Education (i.e., Oregon School Activities Association).

This includes sale of services to students by any person or group that sells, provides, furnishes, contracts for, arranges or advertises travel services.

Sellers of travel services must meet the following district criteria:

1. Belong to an association of sellers of travel certified by the director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services;
2. Provide proof of errors and omissions insurance;
3. Provide proof of a client trust account or performance bond;
4. Submit references;
5. Include in all information provided to students and parents that drug, alcohol and tobacco use will be prohibited;
6. Include in all information provided to students and parents a statement that the activity is a nonschool-sponsored event;
7. Other.

The administration of surveys, questionnaires and requests for information by non-school-connected organizations are disallowed. Exceptions may be approved by the superintendent.
