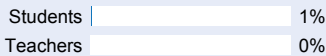

School Environment

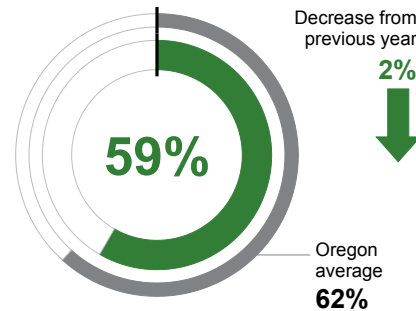
CLASS SIZE

REGULAR ATTENDERS

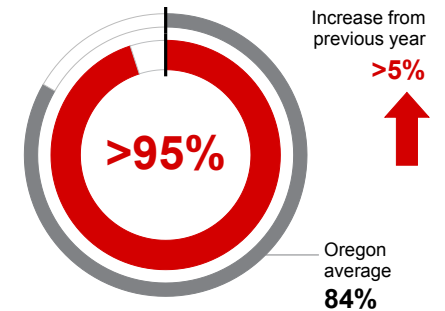
Students who attended more than 90% of their enrolled school days.

ON-TRACK TO GRADUATE

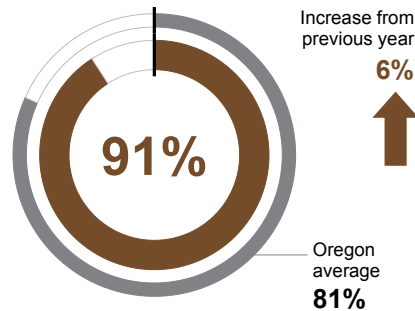
Students earning one-quarter of graduation credits in their 9th grade year.

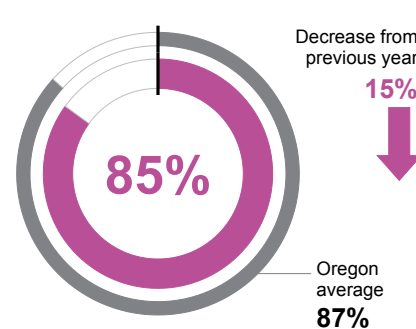
ON-TIME GRADUATION

Students earning a diploma within four years. Cohort includes students who were first-time ninth graders in 2018-19 graduating in 2021-22.



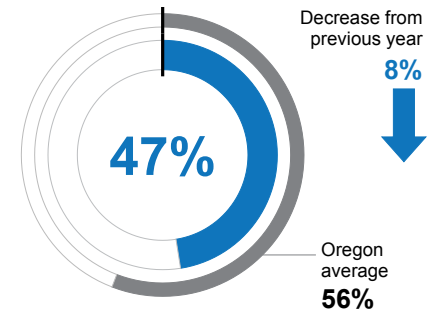
FIVE-YEAR COMPLETION

ECS strives to graduate 100% of its students and develop post-secondary action plans, increase reading and math levels by 20% annually and increase RAR to 90%

State Goals

The Oregon Department of Education is partnering with school districts and local communities to ensure a 90% on-time, four year graduation rate by 2027. To progress toward this goal, the state will prioritize efforts to improve attendance, provide a well-rounded education, invest in implementing culturally responsive practices, and promote continuous improvement to close opportunity and achievement gaps for historically and currently underserved students.

ECS strives to create an environment that is welcoming, safe, inclusive and inspiring for all students, parents/guardians, and the community. ECS has strong partnerships with our Booster Club, local businesses and colleges. 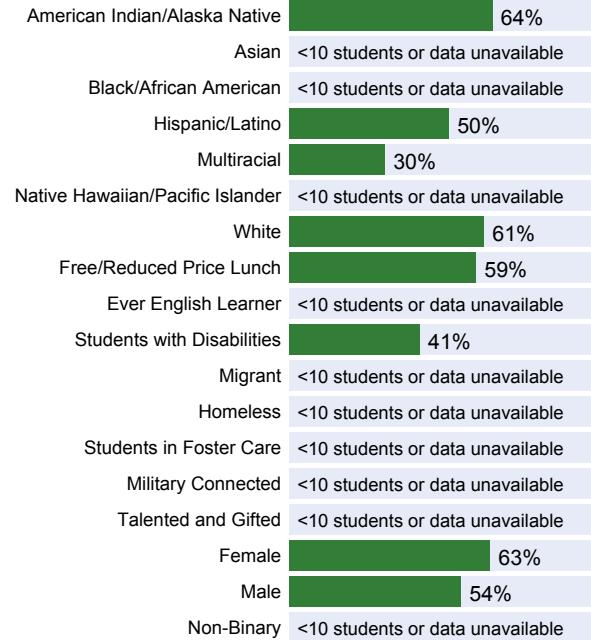

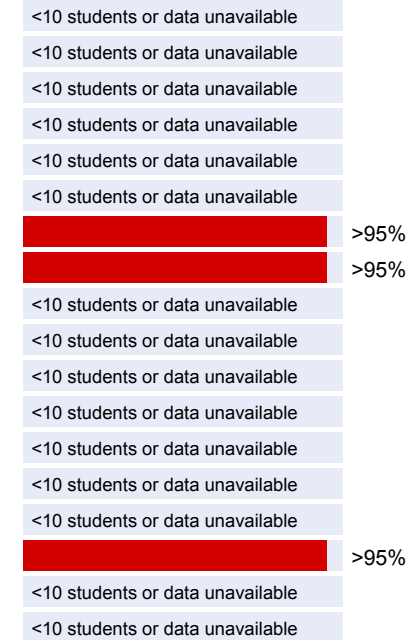

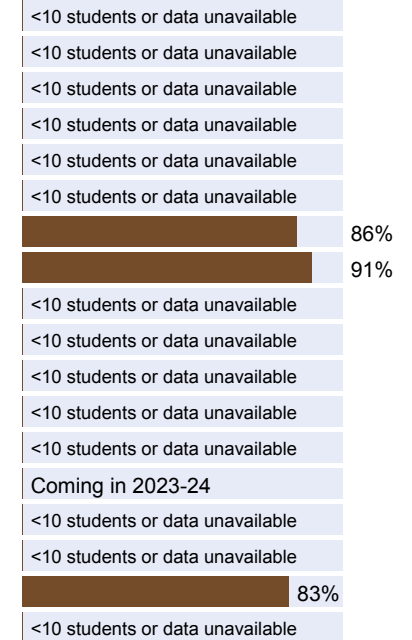

ADVANCED COURSEWORK

ECS offers AP English, Writing 121 and 122, Criminology, AP US History and AP Environmental Science for dual credit.

We also partner with our local community college to engage students in their on-campus and virtual options.

CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION

ECS offers a variety of CTE courses enhancing students' core skills:

Culinary Arts, Woodshop, Welding, 3D printing, Plasma Table Design, Construction, Small Engines, Horticulture, Ag.
