1) Budget Meeting Called to Order by Stephanie Mekemson at 5:00pm

2) Past Meeting Minutes: May 20, 2020

a) Stephanie Mekemson motioned to approve the past meeting minutes, Abe Silvonen seconded. All voting members voted in favor of the motion.

a) Lisa Rorie nominated Stephanie Mekemson as the budget committee chairman, Rebecca Phillips-Sutton seconded the motion. All voting members voted in favor of Stephanie Mekemson as the chair for the budget committee.

5) General Fund Items (Page 7)

- a) Beginning fund balance based on the state fund being at a \$9.3 billion budget
 - i) Revenue from state sources: \$2,583,655.00 (from LCSD)
 - ii) Revenue from local sources: \$39,360.00
 - iii) Beginning fund balance: \$400,000
- b) Staff Compensation Changes:
 - i) All staff will receive a step (2-3%) and insurance cap increase (5%), no COLA
 - ii) PERS rates went down 2-5.2% depending on year
 - iii) New payroll tax (Oregon Paid Family Medical Leave)
 - iv) \$1k Stipend for employees who have stepped out on the salary schedule
 - v) Insurance Opt Out salary \$675 per month (object 144)

- c) Instruction Expenditures Major Changes
 - i) Curriculum adoption money- some could be moved to the ESSER grant
